Want to Become a Certified Compliance and Ethics Professional (CCEP)?

Be recognized for your experience and knowledge in corporate compliance

- Candidates must meet both the work experience and continuing education requirements to be eligible for the exam
- Persons with one year of full-time work experience, or 1,500 hours of compliance-related experience, are eligible for the CCEP exam
- Students attending an accredited university are also eligible for the exam
- Continuing Education: 20 hours must be earned in the 12 months prior to taking the exam (earn CEUs at SCCE events or submit non-SCCE events for accreditation consideration)

How can you prepare for the CCEP exam?

SCCE Academy faculty suggest the following preparation methods:

- Review the *CCEP Candidate Handbook*, focusing on the detailed content outline (www.corporatecompliance.org)
- Read *The Complete Compliance and Ethics Manual* and *Compliance 101* (available from SCCE at www.corporatecompliance.org)

- Attend an SCCE Academy: a week-long event that fulfills the 20 hours of continuing education requirement and offers the CCEP exam on-site (visit www.corporatecompliance.org for an event schedule)
- Review the U.S. Sentencing Guidelines
- *Please Note: The CCEP exam is largely based on professional compliance experience*

Want to stay certified in Compliance and Ethics?

Maintain your CCEP by obtaining 40 hours of continuing education in your two-year certification period

- Attend one of many SCCE events ranging from 1–4 days: earn CEUs and network with your peers
- Earn CEUs for speaking at an event or publishing an article
- Submit non-SCCE sponsored events for accreditation consideration
