whom? For instance, if you have a work presence both in the US and around the world, holding both certifications may be helpful to show your expertise and competence in both realms.

Here's a quick and easy breakdown: CCEP certification is geared toward compliance and ethics laws in the US and is primarily for individuals who work exclusively within the United States.

CCEP-I certification focuses on international compliance and ethics laws and is primarily for individuals who work outside the U.S. or those who have international affiliates.

## Ask Ethical Ellie:

**Q: I'm already a member of HCCA. What is the advantage of also joining SCCE?**

**A:** Getting to know what's going on in healthcare compliance is obviously essential to anyone in healthcare, but it's only a part of the picture. SCCE helps provide compliance and ethics best practices from industries such as manufacturing, technology, oil & gas, insurance. And while those industries may seem distant, you'll find that the challenges across organizations are remarkably similar. The over-arching principles of compliance and ethics can be applied to every organization, in every industry.

**Q: I have my CCEP, is it necessary to get my CCEP-I?**

**A:** Whether or not you should earn your CCEP-I in addition to your CCEP is up to you. I suggest asking yourself a couple questions to help you decide. First ask yourself about your work experience. Do you have any experience working with compliance internationally? Will you encounter that kind of work in the future? The second question is to ask yourself what skill set you are trying to demonstrate, and to
