Every Subcontractor that has PHI or ePHI is also a Business Associate, and therefore must have a BAA.

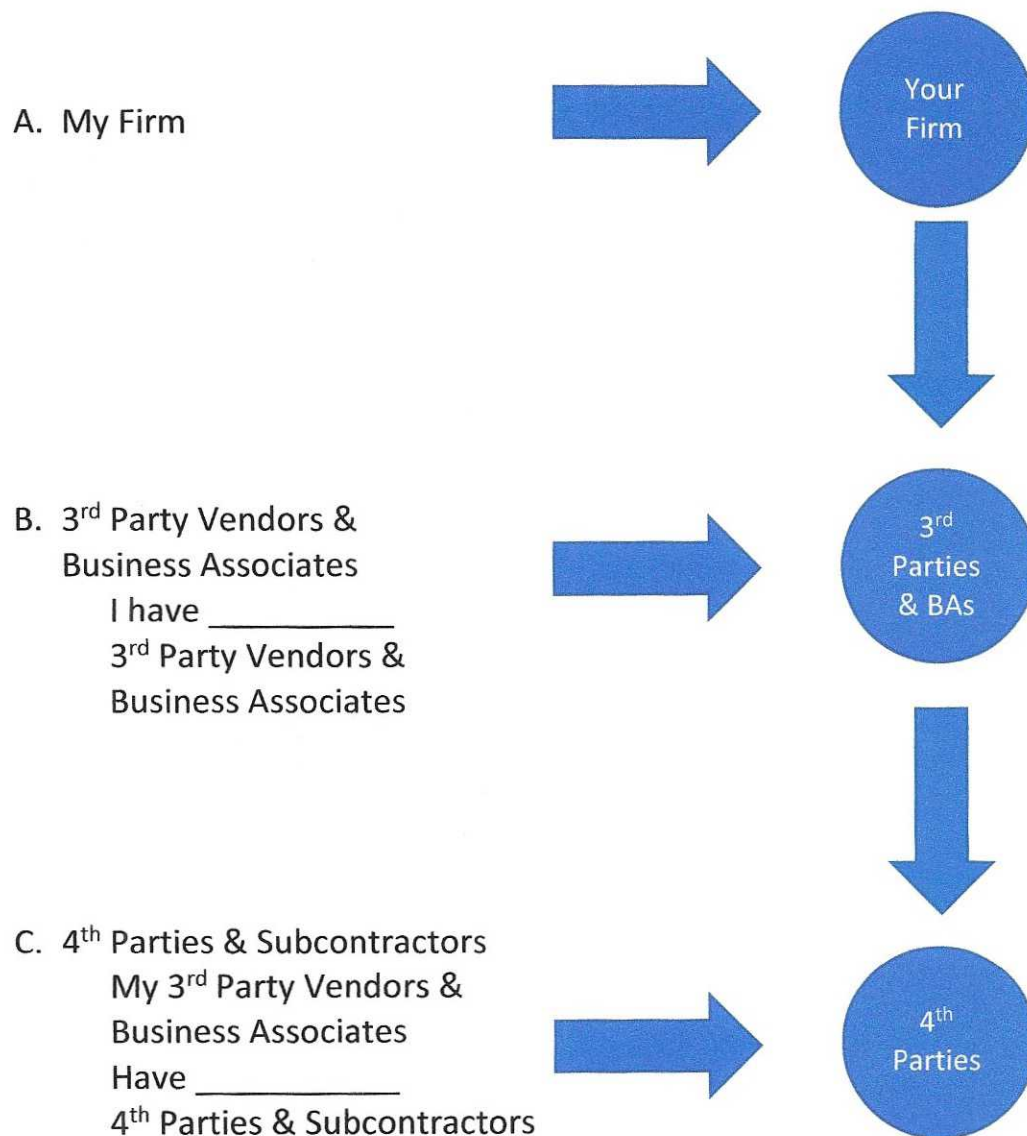
